1. Call to Order (13:30)
 - a. Bucky Whitehouse called the meeting to order at 13:33.

 - a. US Magnesium – Dike eroded and leaked from one pond to another pond.
 - i. US Mag reported an acid release in a retention pond and were starting to see some migration towards BLM property. Posed no hazard to the public. They have been capping the release with clay. No environmental impact.

 - a. Administrative Order from DEQ for Hunter Panels LLC
 - i. Hunter Panels has had an operation that has been shut down the last couple months for maintenance. They have applied for a permit for a new process. They will have someone at the Feb or Mar LEPC meeting to discuss this.
 - b. Davey Bickford Explosives Storage Facility
 - i. Processing plant with large quantities of ammonium nitrate they will store (mining related). Bucky showed a blueprint of the facility (will be attached to minutes). Concern for a catastrophic event plan.

- a. Jay Vance- Stericycle- The public comment period for our solid waste permit ended on January 6, 2017. A number of comments were received including 46 pages of comments from Stericycle. The Utah Division of Waste Management will be reviewing the comments and providing responses. It is expected that the solid waste permit will be finalized and approved. The Utah Division of Air Quality has indicated that their response to comments on the air permit and their finalization and approval of the air permit will occur concurrently with the solid waste permit approval. This means that our air permit and our solid waste permit will be approved at the same time. After those permits are finalized, they then will need to be approved by the Utah legislature and by Governor Herbert before Stericycle is allowed to begin construction.
