- d. Scott McKenzie- TCHD- Mass fatality plan almost finished. The County has been updating their programs with Emergency Management. Just finished updating the disaster behavioral health plan. Primary agency for any response team is Valley Behavioral Health. All hazards plan should be completed by the end of May.
- e. Bucky Whitehouse- EM-
 - i. The COG voted to leave Dispatch under the Sheriff instead of making it a special service district.
 - ii. EM South Mtn. tower location sustained significant damage to the dish last weekend. Radio traffic had to be rerouted to ensure coverage to the south end of the valley.
 - iii. On holiday weekends or special events, we need to be aware of the recreation taking place in the south end of the valley.
 - iv. Working to establish a special event permit so responders can be aware.
