## **Minutes**

- 1. Call to Order (13:30)
  - a. Bucky called the meeting to order at 13:32.
- 2. Welcome/Introductions
  - a. Visitors / New Members
- 3. Sign Roll / Update Rosters
  - a. Herman Herrera made motion to approve the July meeting minutes. Dave Young seconded. All in favor.
- 4. Reports/Action- Local Incident Briefs
  - a. Spill Report Clean Harbors (8/11/2017)
    - **i.** 55 gallon drum. Lost 25 gallons into containment area. Notification was made appropriately.
  - b. Spill Report Nitromethane Barrels (99 Median)
    - i. Had(4) 55 gallon barrels show up in the media. Barrels were empty. UDOT picked them up
  - c. Update on the Ammonium Thiosulphate Spill
    - i. Semi trailer rolled over and lost 75-100 gallons of diesel into the area and an unknown amount of Ammonium Thiosulphate. TCHD got ahold of trucking company and assured the product is not hazardous. Bigger issue is diesel spill. Looking for sampling results. The LEPC will be sending out a letter to remind company of their obligations to clean up the spill and get in touch with the Health Dept or fines could result. This has created an undue burden on Dominion from the excessive calls about the smell in the area.
  - d. Update on Benson Grist Mill hazmat spill/clean-up
    - i. Privately owned area in vicinity of Benson Grist Mill. An individual is parting out a piece of heavy equipment on his property. He is storing fluids in barrels and the public is reporting the site.
  - e. Natural Gas Line Ruptures
    - i. We have had a significant number of natural gas line ruptures. One just last week on Tooele Main Street. They discovered the line was severed. The line will be vacated and a

new line will be sent through to restore the area. Problem on Garden Street behind Police Station as well. The line was hit and caused a leak a little way down the road. There is a lot of activity in the streets with utilities that is increasing the natural gas line problems.

- ii. Power Outage in Tooele City
  - **1.** 9000 customers out of power. Rocky Mtn Power quickly got people there and it lasted about an hour and 40 min.
- iii. Semi Rollover at MM 90
  - 1. The semi lost a little fuel. It stayed intact. NTFD responded.

- c. Paul Oglvie- Rocky Mtn Care Center- They would like to be more involved in the LEPC. There are some new regulations that will go into effect this year. They will be needing to participate in any community exercises.
  - i. There are some exercises planned. Dugway was not able to hold theirs in Sept due to the fire they experienced. There will be an exercise in Oct.
- d. Jay Vance- Stericycle- Indications from the Utah Department of Environmental Quality continue to be that Stericycle's permits will be issued around the end of August (any day now). Following our receipt of approved Utah DEQ permits, Stericycle will apply for local permits (building permit and a Tooele Health Department permit). As outlined in the agreement with the Utah DEQ, once all required state and local permits for construction are in hand and approved as "non-appealable", Stericycle will have three years to move its incinerator operation in North Salt Lake to the Tooele County site without penalty.
- e. Marianne Oborn- TCSD- There is a new SafeUT app thru the U of U. There is a glitch in the messaging but it should be good soon. Please encourage everyone to get it on their phone.
- f. Regina Nelson- Dispatch- TIM training is coming up Sept 11<sup>th</sup> 2-4 and 13<sup>th</sup> 2-4 at the EOC. It replaces an ICS class. The class is free.
- g. Tina Worcester- Dugway- CERT Training flyer will be sent out.
- h. Steve Griffith- TEAD- They are in the permitting process to move the OBOD from north to south.
- i. Herman Herrera- US Mag- Fire rescue training out at their facility. They are looking for some fire extrication equipment. Lock Down Drill in Sept.
- j. Matt LaFrance- TCHD- Flu Vaccine has been received. They will be doing flu clinics in the schools.
- k. Glenn Reinicke- MWMC- Completed a drill last week. They will drill quarterly. The next one will be a power outage. They will text Rocky Mtn Care Center evacuation plans. Not sure which direction they will evacuate to but Fire and Law are welcome to participate.
- I. Bucky Whitehouse-TCEM- Cougar was spotted in Overlake Area. We sent out a Tooele Alerts message to the public. We are perfecting that form of mass notification.
