  - ii. They are working with personal radiation detectors that are very high quality. They also have some detectors that look like pagers. They give out a reading on a scale. They have issued 12 of those out now. Tooele will be issued one asap.

- a. **Jay Vance- Stericycle-** They are status quo
- b. Regina Nelson- Dispatch- Working on Quickest Route. It will go live on Nov 16<sup>th</sup>. They will roll out the end of Nov. It will tell dispatch the nearest unit, so they can dispatch quicker. They will have AVL in all ambulances. It has been a year project and Todd Turner has worked tirelessly on it.
- c. Bucky Whitehouse-TCEM- Tooele Technical College is working on bringing POST (Peace Officer Training) to Tooele. They are also looking in the future to firefighting and EMS as an option as well.
- d. Craig Tate- TEAD- They got their state permits for open detonation. April 1- Oct 31 is the only time the can do the open detonation.
- e. Eric Grange- Clean Harbors- They are meeting with Macintosh to look at increasing communications capabilities at their grassy mountain location. They have some older infrastructure that was used in the older days of Clive that may need upgrading. They plan to work with TCEM and Dispatch on improving communications in the county.
- f. Bucky Whitehouse- TCEM- last Wednesday a proposal to change some densities within Overlake area near the Union Pacific Rail Line. There was discussion about what type of stipulations needed to be in effect to protect the rail system. They city council will have this on the upcoming agenda. During a prior meeting Airgas received a permit for nitrous oxide to be added to the Utah industrial depot. The Utah motorsports campus has been sold to Mitime. Across the street from there is a planned industrial park, the Romney Development. It will be a commercial area of 900 acres. Bucky would like to have someone from Peterson Industrial come and do a presentation on all the partners out there. Desert UAS had a kickoff event last week for a drone system in Tooele County. They are looking to fly in the south range and UTTR as well. We will plan to have them come do a presentation for the LEPC also.
