b. Power Outage June 13th along SR-36 due to extreme weather event.

- i. A microcell occurred in Tooele County and caused several lightning caused fires. 10 consecutive power poles were affected along SR 36 and power was lost.

c. Tooele County Weed Abatement / Fire wise Mitigation

- i. Tooele City Code Enforcement have been active in making sure mow strips are in place to protect properties from fire. The County is meeting to create consistency and continuity between municipal governments.
