## Minutes 6-30-21

- 1. Call to Order (13:30)
  - a. Bucky called the meeting to order at 1:35 PM.

- 3. Sign Roll / Update Rosters

- 4. Approve Minutes –May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021
  - a. Bryan Slade made motion to approve May meeting minutes. Seconded by Richard Moseley. All in favor.
- 5. Local Incidents Events
  - a. Morgan Canyon Fire
    - i. Several hundred-acre wildfire due to a downed aircraft. There was a complex response. Beginning July 8<sup>th</sup> will be wreckage removal. 40% contained to date.
  - b. Grantsville Flooding Event
    - i. Rainfall 1.3 Inches in 1 hour 6 homes flooded.
      - **1.** Grantsville public works responded and provided sandbags to the area.
- 6. Update Tooele County COVID-19 Response
  - a. Tracy Frailey-TCHD
    - i. 53,000 doses distributed. They are having a group of people that need to receive their second dose. They are focusing their efforts on the 12-18 yr old age group. A handout was provided with data. They have a vaccination clinic open every day at the Health Dept. They can provide a mobile clinic to business if requested. There are also pharmacies that can provide the vaccine. They will try and encourage sports teams to be vaccinated this summer before school starts. There are no restrictions on mass gatherings.
  - b. Glenn Reinicke- MWMC
    - i. They have a few people at the hospital currently that are COVID positive. Break through cases are sent to the hospital for sequencing.

- 9. Update Grantsville Planned Power Outage July 11, 2021 (11PM-4AM)
  - a. Rocky Mtn Power will hold a planned outage on July 11 at 11PM. 4500 customers will be without power. It will be restored Monday July 12<sup>th</sup> at 4 AM. They have a system to notify customers. Customers out west will not be impacted. The EOC will be providing sign boards for public messaging.

#### **10. Update- Tooele County Drought Forecast**

a. Our county has D3 and D4 drought areas. Mitigation is the key for extenuating problems from the drought.
